

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

Due to the declaration by Governor Roy Cooper of a state of emergency for Tropical Storm Florence on September 07, 2018, FirstCarolinaCare Insurance Company (FCC) has put into effect certain temporary rules intended to help ensure members can access care and medications without undue disruption during the emergency period. During the emergency period, the following rules are in effect:

- Members may obtain services at specified non-contracted facilities;
- Requirements for specialist referrals are waived, where applicable;
- Cost-sharing for plan-approved out-of-network health services are reduced to the in-network cost-sharing level (for example, for a plan-approved hospital stay, the member cost would be the daily in-network copayment amount instead of the usual out-of-network 20% coinsurance);
- Explanation of Benefits for medical claims incurred during the emergency period may be delayed;
- Pharmacies will be able to override certain prescription drugs restrictions for members displaced during the emergency. This will allow prior approval requirements and certain other limitations (including: early refills, prior authorization requirements, step therapy requirements and certain quantity limitations) to be waived for impacted members during the emergency period.
- Subject to applicable reimbursement policies, displaced members may be reimbursed for costs of prescriptions purchased from out-of-network pharmacies.
